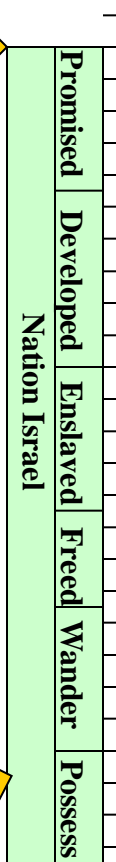


**God Calls Abraham Out of a Land of Idolatry and Promises to Make of His Seed a Great Nation.**

**Abrahamic Covenant  
Genesis 12:1-3**

**Seven Promises**

- 1.) "I will make of thee a great nation:"
  - a. Natural posterity to be "as the dust"
  - b. Spiritual posterity as "the stars"
- 2.) "I will bless thee,"
- 3.) "... Make thy name great"
- 4.) "And thou shalt be a blessing" (thru him would come the chosen seed of Christ, and the Holy Scriptures.)
- 5.) "I will bless them that bless thee."
- 6.) "I will curse him that curseth thee."
- 7.) "In thee shall all families of the earth be blessed." (In Christ this is fulfilled spiritually, and in the Millennium it will be fulfilled temporally.)

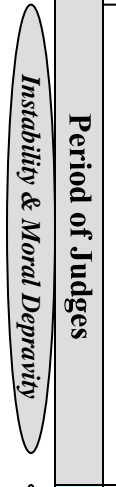
**Deuteronomy 28-30**  
 "... If you diligently obey the voice of the Lord:"

- \* God will set you high above all nations.
- \* Blessed in the city and in the country.
- \* Blessed with children.
- \* Blessed with produce from the ground.
- \* Cattle and flocks will increase.
- \* Abundant food.
- \* Enemies will be defeated and will flee.
- \* Lord will bless all you do.
- \* Rain in your land in its season.
- \* The head nation, not the tail.

"... If you do not obey the voice of the Lord:"

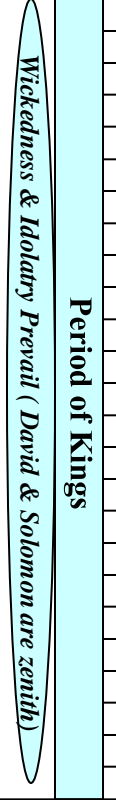
- \* Cursed in the city and in the country.
- \* Cursed shall be your food.
- \* Cursed shall be the fruit of your body.
- \* Cursed shall be the produce of your land.
- \* Cursed shall be the increase of cattle & flocks.
- \* Cursed in all that you do.
- \* Consumed with sickness and death.
- \* Rain will be withheld; you will be destroyed.
- \* Stricken with sickness that cannot be cured.
- \* You will go into captivity to serve other gods.
- \* Locusts shall consume your trees & produce.
- \* Besieged & overrun by a far away enemy.
- \* Besieged, you will eat your own children.
- \* You will be left few in number.
- \* You will be scattered among all nations.
